A word of thanks to all those families who paid the PSG fees so promptly: we had 52 payments up to now! You know that we will spend the money to organize special events at school and useful items.



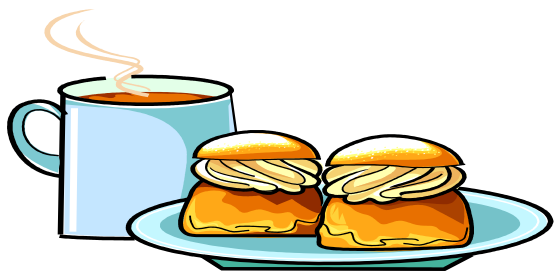
